



# Viewbank Tennis Club – Fencing Project

Viewbank Tennis Club Members,

You may be aware that Viewbank Tennis Club is about to undertake a major project involving the replacement of much of the fencing in and around our Club property.

Existing fences will be replaced around all Courts other than Courts 7 & 8.

These 2 Court fences have been left untouched at this stage because it is our intention to re-develop these Court surfaces and therefore, it made no sense to install new fences only to have to remove them later to update the courts.

This Fencing project will commence on **Monday September 12<sup>th</sup>** and should take approximately 2-3 weeks to complete. We have scheduled this work to occur in the School Holidays to minimise the disruption and inconvenience to Competition Tennis as much as possible.

This project will also see the pruning back or removal of many of the trees which are impacting on the existing fences. Council have undertaken to complete this task, and have advised that they will be re-planting in instances where trees are removed.

Your patience and understanding is appreciated in this time. Please be aware that the Club will be a worksite in this period - and so we ask you and your children, and guests to take extra care if you are at the club throughout this installation.

On behalf of the Viewbank Tennis Club Committee, I apologise for any inconvenience. I am certain however that the end result will represent a significant improvement to our facility, and more than worth the short term hassles.
