Courts access will be limited to members and coaching clientele who:

- HAVE NOT BEEN OUT OF THE COUNTRY FOR THE PAST 14 DAYS;
- ARE NOT IN SELF-ISOLATION AND HAVE NOT BEEN REQUIRED TO DO SO;
- ARE NOT DISPLAYING ANY SYMPTONS OF COLD/SORE THROAT ETC. (IF YOU ARE WE ASK THAT YOU STAY HOME UNTIL THESE SYMPTONS PASS.

Return to play rules

- Courts are open for play on weekdays: 12-1pm, 4-5pm
- Courts are open for play on the weekend: 9am-5pm
- Coaching program: Courts 1&2 and 7&8 (Coaching program only, no social tennis)
- Social play for financial members only: Courts 3, 4 & 6 (entry from the main gate)
- Members wanting to play will be required to **book online via our website** <http://www.viewbanktc.com.au/court-bookings/>.
- Court bookings will be a **maximum of 45 minutes starting from the hour**, booking/registering is essential. *(Please note: the booking system will be available from Saturday 23rd May 2020 to take bookings).*
- No booking registration of all players, No play.
- Before entering the club, we request that all members download and use the COVID Safe App on their phone.
- The rule will be to Get in, Play, Get Out (consistent with advice provided by Tennis Australia).
- There should be no off-court gatherings.
- All activity must be on court - you cannot wait in the club rooms or on the benches/seats/huts outside.
- Everyone, regardless of their role, must arrive and leave as close as possible to when they need to at the venue.
- Singles and doubles play will be allowed.
- Bring your own balls and equipment, with a limit of 4 balls only per court.
- Please maintain a 1.5m distance while attending a tennis activity.
- Please follow the recommended hygiene protocols (we have published these at the club) – Members are requested to wash their hands before leaving home to protect against infection Please use hand sanitizer provided at the club, please don't share equipment or drink bottles.
- Remember no handshakes or High Fives, try tapping racquets instead.
- Children under the age of 15 will have to be accompanied by a playing adult
- Where possible, members must use their racquet or foot to hit balls to their partner or opponent or to return a ball that has come from another court.
- Players exchanging ends must do so are either side of the net.
- Brooms/baggers must be wiped down after use, with wipes provided.
- Members should avoid using hand rails on steps and wipe down after use.
- Hand sanitiser and wipes will be provided by the club for use of members, which will be under cover outside the clubhouse. Please wipe down the front gate for immediate use after entering and leaving the club. Please also wipe down gate handles.
- The clubhouse, BBQ area, chairs, bench seating and huts will be closed.
- Drink taps will also be turned off and not in use (please remember to bring your own bottle of water).
